

Using the mRIDGE Project Management Center (mRIDGE PMC)

Go to the web page of the project at: <http://mridge.dipseil.net>

From the web page menu to the left (fig.1), choose “PMC”. If your browser asks you about the validity of the certificate, confirm that you know the certificate is valid.

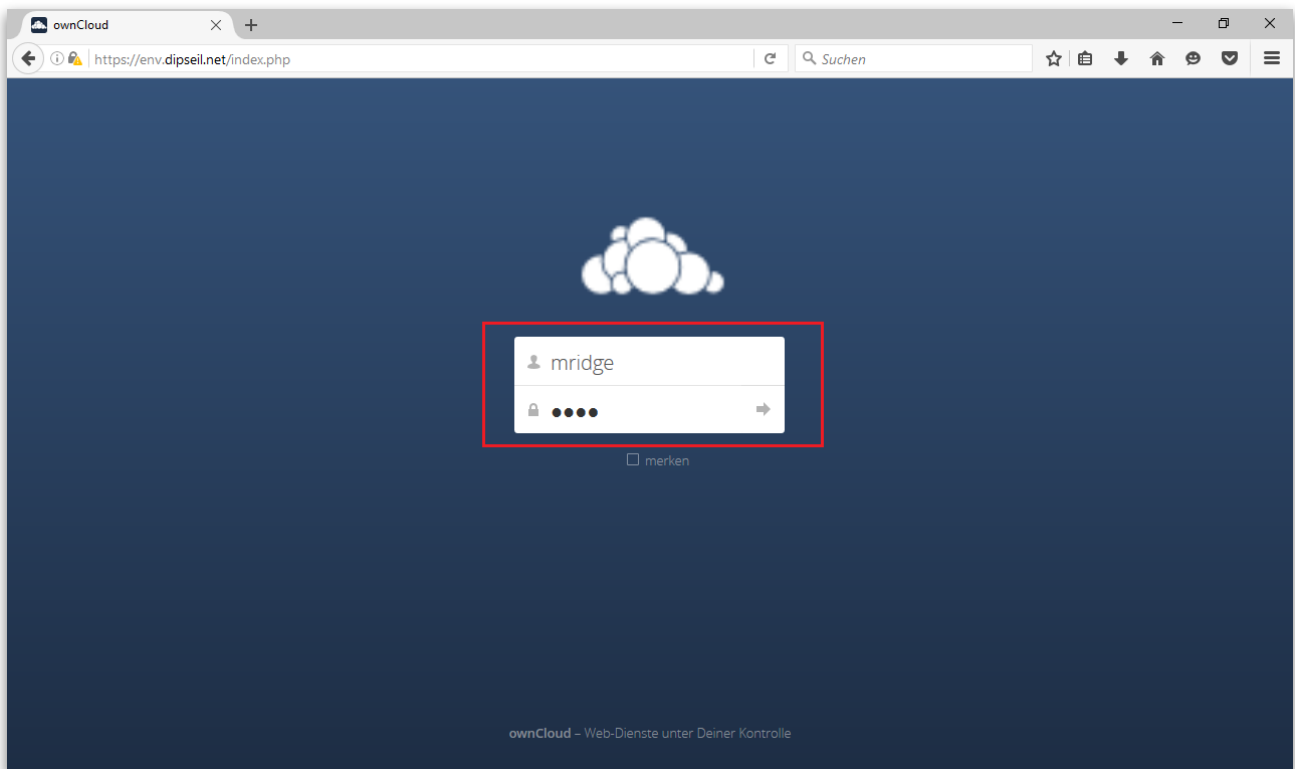


Figure 2: The login page of the mRIDGE PMC

In the new screen, type your username and password in (fig.2). If you don't have any, please contact either Prof. Nevena Mileva (nevena.mileva@gmail.com) or Mihail Milev (mmilev@dipseil.net) to receive an account.

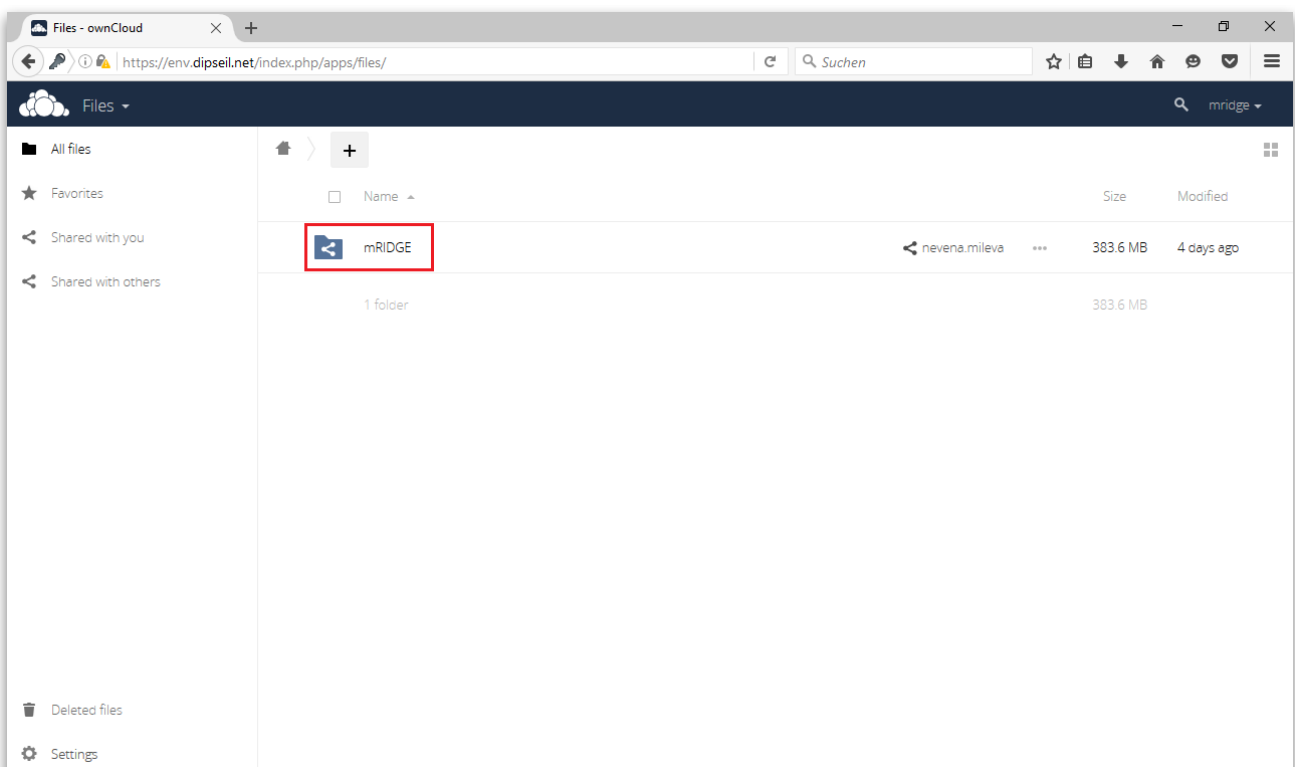


Figure 3: Home view of the mRIDGE PMC

Once inside, you will see a shared area for you from the PMC system named “mRIDGE” (fig.3). To enter inside this area, click on “mRIDGE”.

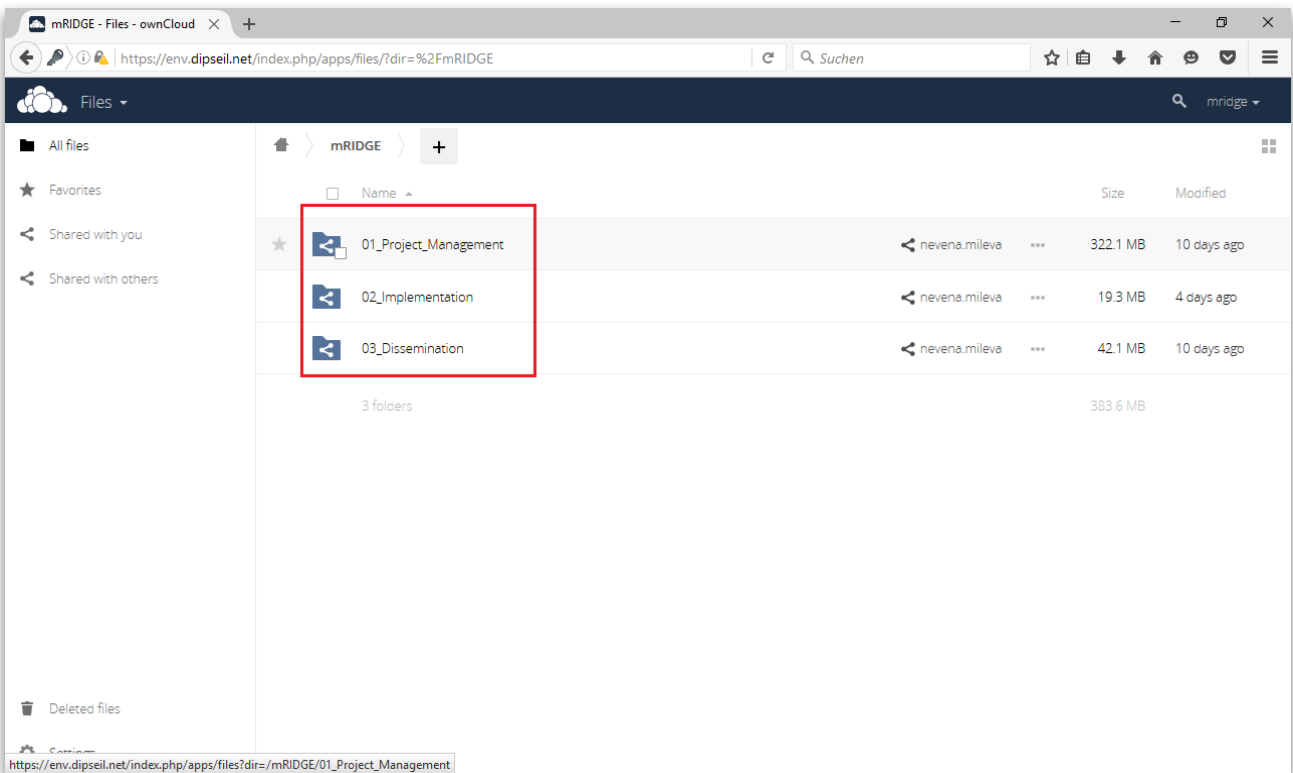


Figure 4: Elements of the mRIDGE PMC at current level

At each level of the system you can click on any of the objects in the list to go further down the project structure (fig. 4).

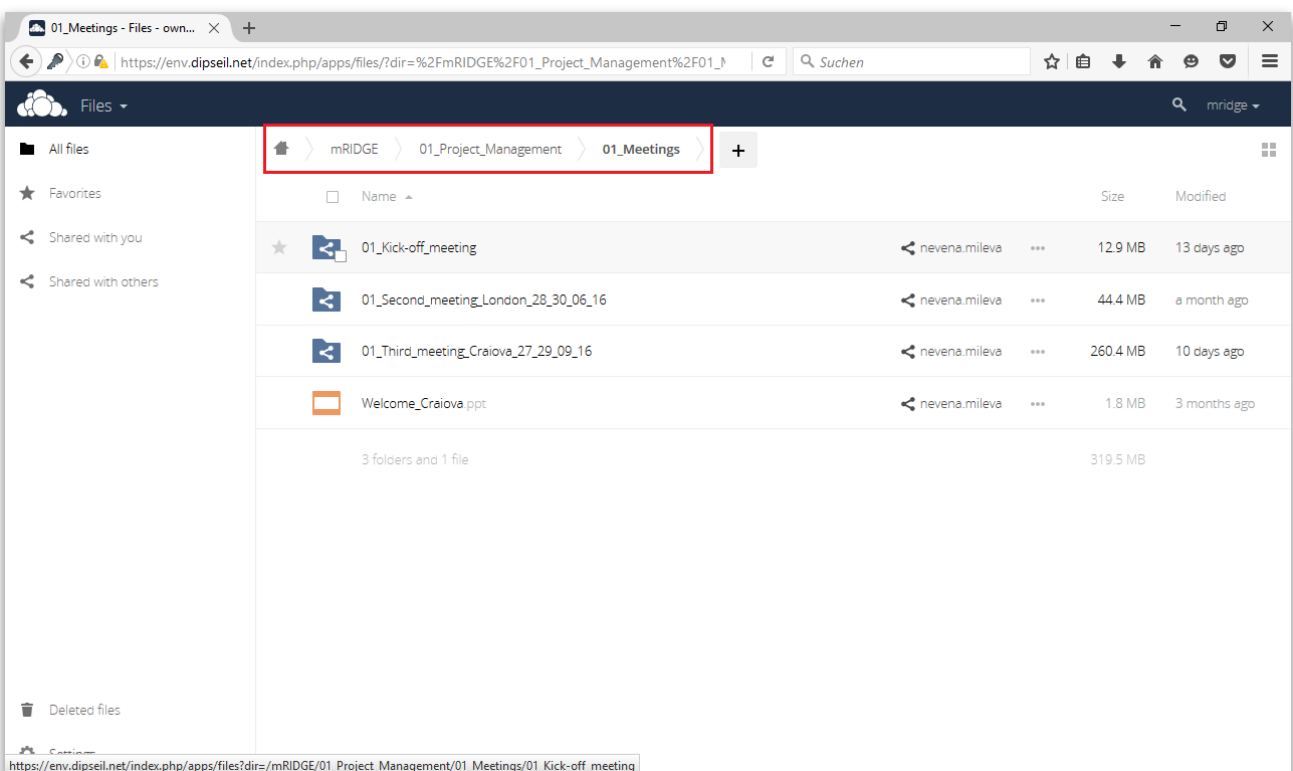


Figure 5: The full path view

You may notice, that above the list, the full path to your current location is displayed (fig. 5). You can go back to any higher step of the hierarchy by click on one of the elements from this list.

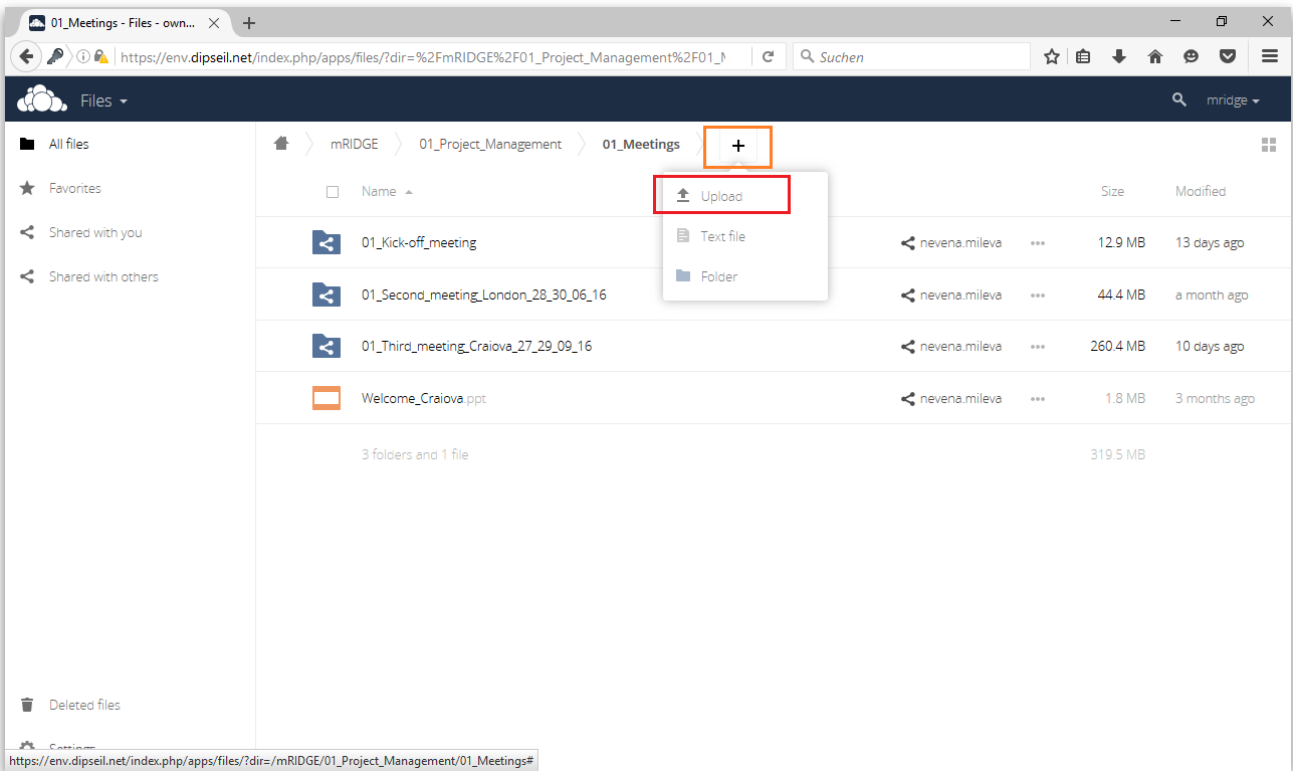


Figure 6: Uploading a file

To upload a new file to the system, click on the plus button next to the full path area above the list (fig. 6). From the newly displayed context menu, choose upload. A “Choose a file...” dialog box will be displayed, prompting you to choose a local file from your computer for upload.

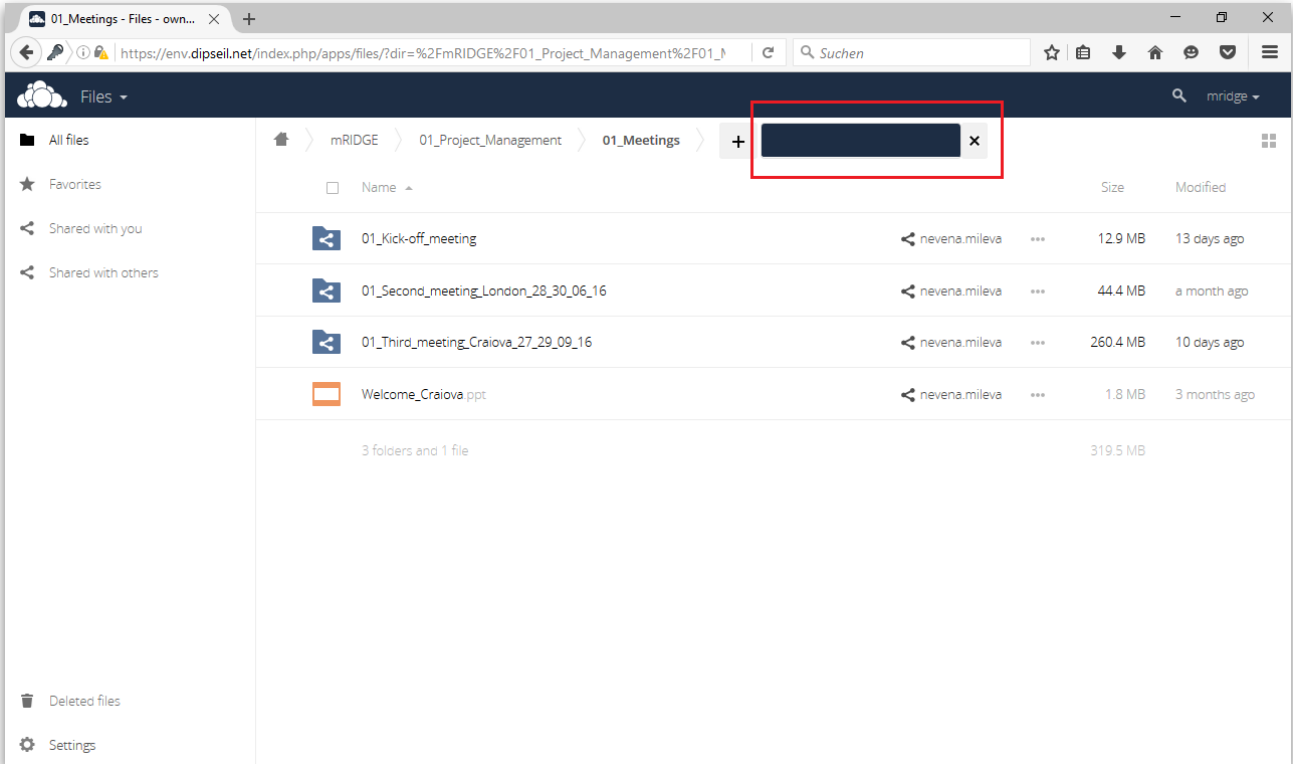


Figure 7: Upload file progress bar

During upload, a status bar will be displayed next to the plus button (fig. 7). It will display the current upload process.

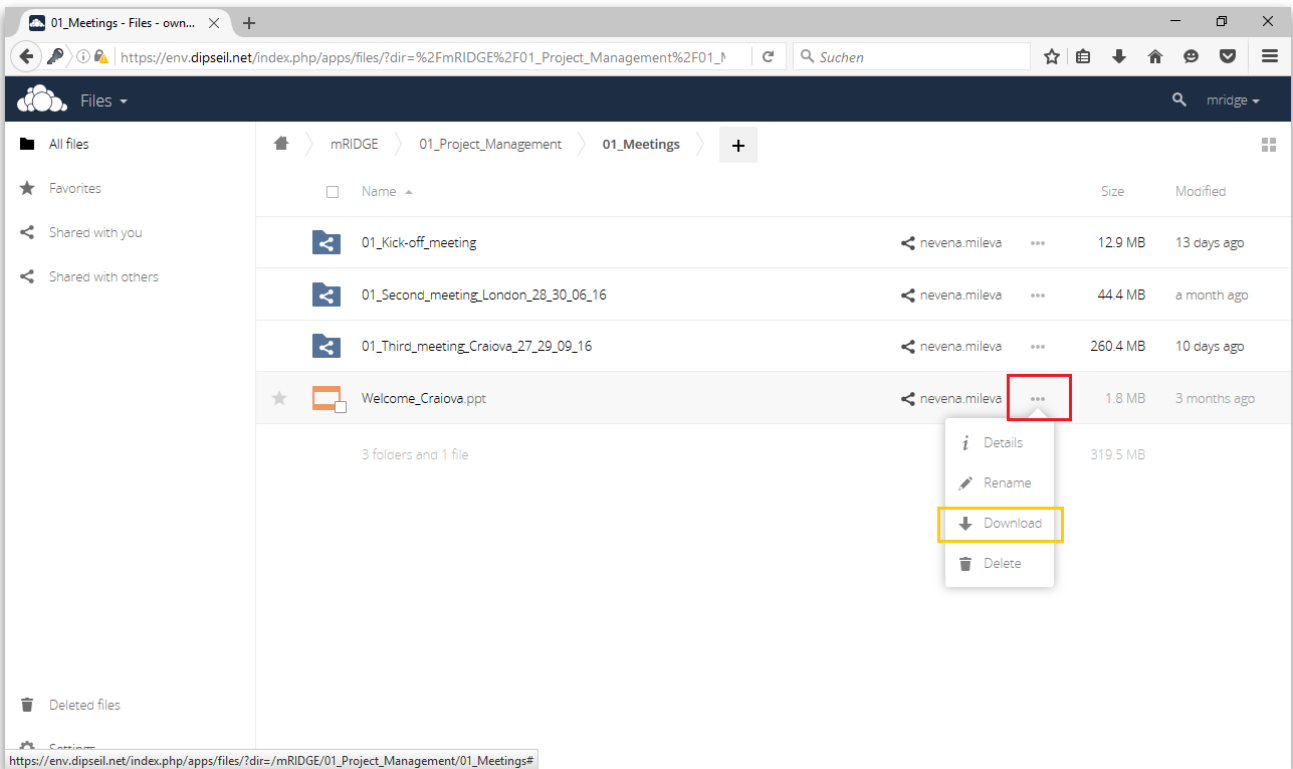


Figure 8: Downloading a file

To download an uploaded file, click on the “three dots” button next to the file title (fig. 8). Again, a context menu will be displayed. Choose “Download” from it.

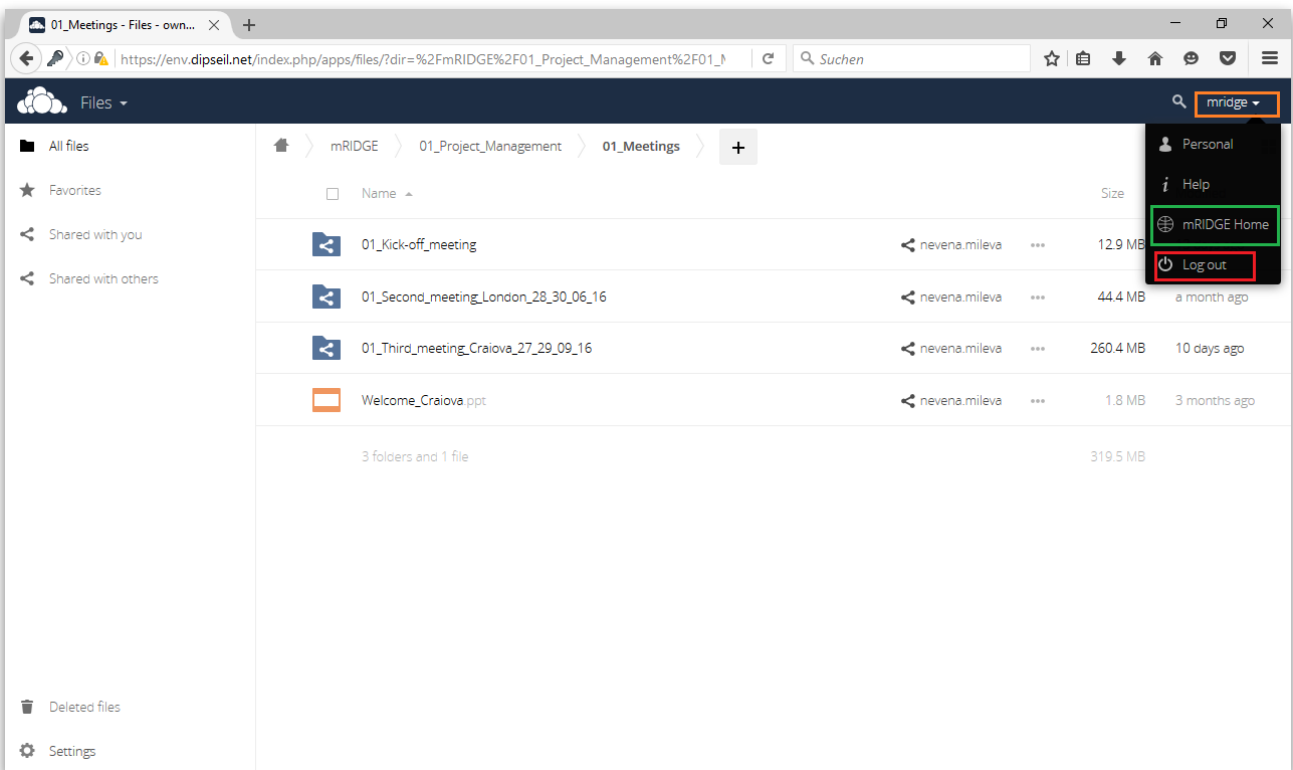


Figure 9: Exiting the mRIDGE PMC

Once you are done working with the system you can exit from it using the personal menu at the top right of your browser screen (fig. 9). Choose the arrow next to your login name. From the new context menu, you have to exit options:

- “mRIDGE Home” will exit the system and forward you to the mRIDGE project home page;
- “Log out” will exit the system and terminate your session with the mRIDGE project home page.
